Measuring What Matters: System-wide Assessment Practices for Deep Learning

Assessment does more than measure student achievement at the end of a unit or school year. It establishes expectations for the kinds of thinking we want from our students, and it compels us to elevate our teaching practices to engage students in complex, authentic learning. “Teaching to the test” becomes a worthy endeavor when “the test” is teacher-designed; reflects shared site or district values, and measures meaningful, long-term goals for student performance.

Session participants will gain tips and tools to design assessments that are worth teaching to. In this interactive workshop, we will:

- ▶ explore frameworks for authentic assessment design,
- ▶ analyze the role of assessment in the big picture of 21st century curriculum and instruction, and
- ▶ experience hands-on processes that support assessment design, implementation, and refinement.

Whether your school or district assessment work is just beginning or well underway, the tools, templates, and processes shared in this workshop will help you reflect upon your practice and consider meaningful next steps for your team’s, school’s, or district’s assessment journey.
