Let It All Workout Little Wayne

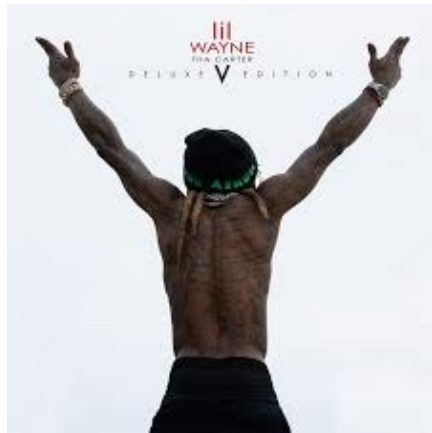
Said, "Relax, Tune, baby don't stress out"

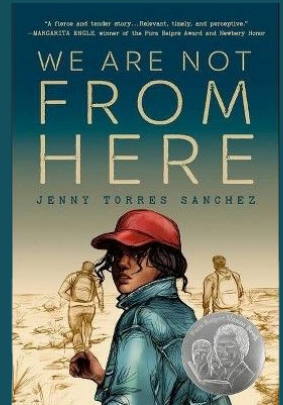
Definition of Global Citizenship

1st Media (Avengers Endgame)

2nd Media (Papers, Please)

In "Papers, Please," an example of global citizenship is illustrated through the player's interactions with immigrants who have fled persecution or seek refuge from neighboring countries. For instance, a character might present documents indicating they are a political dissident or a refugee escaping conflict in a neighboring nation.

As the player, you must decide whether to allow them entry into Arstotzka, balancing the strict regulations of the state with your empathy for their situations. In this scenario, demonstrating global citizenship involves considering the individual's human rights and safety, irrespective of their nationality or the bureaucratic hurdles they face.



3rd Media (PeaceMaker)

"PeaceMaker" is a simulation video game where players take on the role of either the Israeli Prime Minister or the Palestinian President. Their objective is to navigate complex political, social, and economic challenges to achieve peace in the Israeli-Palestinian conflict. The game emphasizes diplomacy, conflict resolution, and empathy, offering players insights into the complexities of the conflict and encouraging critical thinking about real-world issues.



4th Media (Poem)
